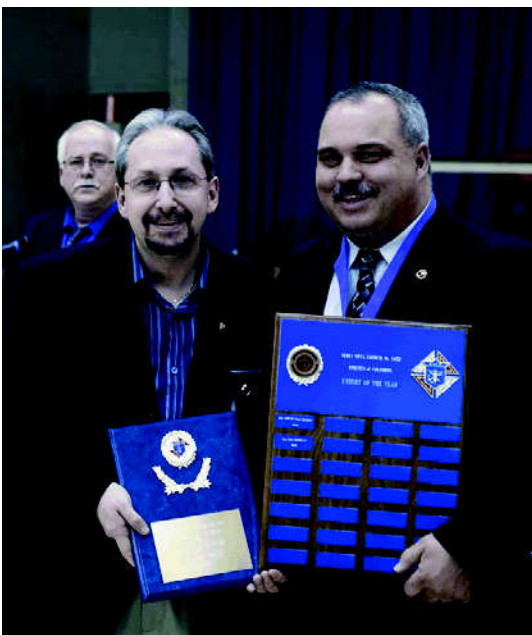
Ron is a member of the Royal St. John's Regatta Committee for the past 28 years and has served in various positions.

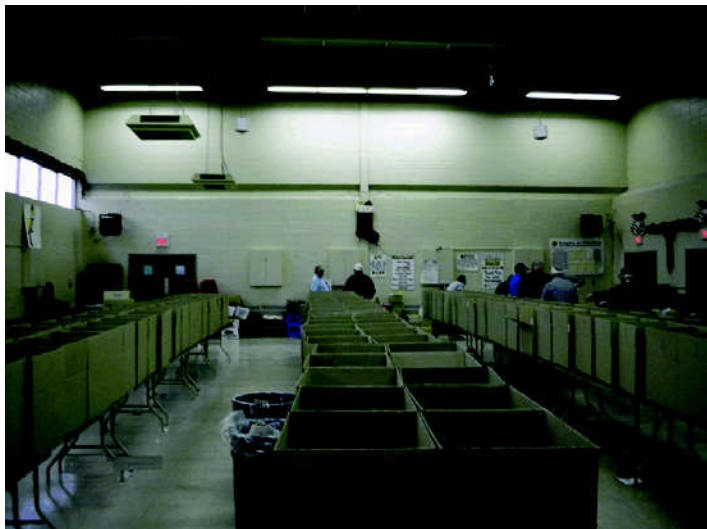

Our Assembly laid a wreath at the Memorial Monument on Harvey Road on November 11, 2010 in honour of those who died in the K of C fire.

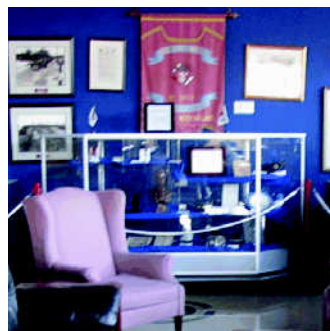
Our Assembly is holding our 50/50 draws again this year and we look forward to the continued support and cooperation of TNC members in this fundraiser for our Assembly.
